CALL FOR PAPERS

The Canadian Studies Center at the Universitat de Barcelona and the Spanish Association for Canadian Studies are organizing the Twelfth European Seminar for Graduate Students in Canadian Studies 2003.

The seminar will be held at the Universitat de Barcelona (Spain), 10-12 October 2003. European students working on a master's thesis or a doctoral dissertation in Canadian Studies are invited to present their current research findings and to exchange ideas with canadianists from other countries.

Presentations can be given in English or French. They should not exceed 20 minutes and will be followed by discussion (10 minutes each). It is planned to publish the best papers. The seminar sessions will be chaired by established European or Canadian scholars in the field of Canadian studies.

The first session will start on Friday, 10th October, at 9.30; and the last one will end on Saturday, 11th October.

How to apply?

Anyone interested in participating should submit an abstract (1-2 pages), indicating their topic of research and the nature of their findings, plus a short CV. Papers will be selected by the scientific committee on the basis of the abstract. Invitations to participate will be sent out as soon as possible after the selection has been made.

Deadline for abstracts: 15 June 2003.

Official languages: English and French.

Number of students admitted: 25-30.

Registration fee: 20 € (to be paid at the registration desk)

Travel expenses: Students responsibility. Please apply financial assistance to your university or your national association for Canadian Studies.

Boarding:

Accommodation (3 nights: from Thursday 9th October to Sunday 12th October) and meals will be paid by the European Network on Canadian Studies; the Center for CS at the University of Barcelona and the Spanish Association for Canadian Studies. The students will be lodged at a university residence. Some may be asked to share rooms.
